Survey background and purpose

Background

- Pandemic situation in Europe: difficult to predict how the virus will spread and whether traveling will or will not be possible for the intended EURAM conference in December.
- Need for information on how the Covid-19 pandemic evolves and affects universities and our members.


Purpose: to collect information on

- The national, institutional and personal issues affecting our members' participation in the December conference, and
- Members' expectations toward possible other EURAM activities during this year.


Implementation

- SurveyMonkey survey
- Open 12 19 May
- Possibly another survey later, to continue monitoring the situation

Data: 926 responses over 4.037 recipients (response rate 23%)












Q1: Do you plan to attend any academic events or conferences live onsite (with physical presence) this year?




Q2: If a live, on-site EURAM conference is organised in Dublin on 4-6 December, do you plan to attend?






If a <u>virtual, on-line</u> EURAM conference is organised instead of the on-site conference, do you plan to attend?

Q5: Which activities would you like to attend in a virtual on-line




Q6: Which of the two do you prefer now (over six months before the conference)?





Q8 Which factors will affect your decision to attend the on-site conference? "Other"

Financial issues: uncertainty on available funds for conferences ("allowances are frozen") (18)

Travel-related issues: visa; local development of covid-19 in Ireland; Ireland cold in December; flight availability; uncertainty about if traveling is allowed from one's home country (12)

Health issues: avoidance of social contacts; being in a risk group; unavailability of treatment and vaccines; ongoing recovery from virus; fear of getting sick; possible quarantine after travel (10)


Personal issues: young children; relocation; ending of work contract (5)

Other: increased workload; timing between Thanksgiving and Christmas and at term end; other participants' decisions; necessity (as track chairs); "basically on-site conferences are just the past, and not eco-friendly and cost-efficient whatsoever" (6)


Virtual program track building

Concerns / issues regarding on-line arrangements

- Some people are strictly not interested to attend on-line conferences Security
- Technical conditions / connections
- Fee not all institutions can fund participation in virtual activities
- June-October not a viable option for virtual activities for some people (vacations + teaching)

Q12 Other ideas and comments concerning the possible rearrangements for EURAM 2020 conference and other activities during this year

Four scenarios based on the responses:

Dublin December –

postpone the decision to July/August 21 comments

Dublin later –

postpone the conference again 15 comments

All virtual at least this year – let's not take any risks

35 comments

Something else – cancel or think more creatively

Q12 Other ideas and comments concerning the possible rearrangements for EURAM 2020 conference and other activities during this year

Dublin December – postpone the decision to July/August

- "Only a physical conference makes sense"; "please keep the on-site conference"
- The pandemic should be past in the fall
- Online option will not give the benefit
- Organize more flexibly, with a smaller nr of participants
- Take care of safety
- Celebrate for recovery
- Some respondents propose reopening submission and review, to add participants

Dublin later (2021→)– postpone the conference again

- "If not in December, then 2021 in Dublin would be great"
- People are waiting to spend quality time together in Dublin
- Spring or June 2021
- Visa issues for long-distance participants are important
- Some respondents propose just postponing and keeping the same papers; others mention that the papers of this year will be outdated (or submitted elsewhere) by next June

Q12 Other ideas and comments concerning the possible rearrangements for EURAM 2020 conference and other activities during this year

All virtual at least this year – let's not take any risks

- "If not on-site, then at least on-line"; "If needed, I am willing to contribute..." vs. "If it is virtual, I will not attend".
- Uncertainties are currently emphasized and many would prefer an online option; universities may discourage travel
- People may be more likely to participate without a paper
- Some respondents gave examples of good practices in online arrangements – on-line can be successful!
- Wish for some form of networking, besides formal sessions
- Need to differentiate from other on-line events
- Concerns/issues to handle: Price and affordability/funding access of virtual activities; time-zone differences (Australia, Far East, Americas...); nr of participants in a virtual activity needs to be limited; virtual meetings are very strenuous and need to be short; possible overlap with teaching/exams; creativity needed it is not the same as on-site!

Something else – cancel or think more creatively

- "Just cancel it", "let it go"
- Have a shorter version online
- Allow people to selforganize around topics
- On-line and virtual in parallel
- Adjust the theme to Covid-19
- Maybe simulate people to make an academic hackathon






