# 1<sup>st</sup> Paper Development Workshop

#### What

The purpose of the 1<sup>st</sup> EURAM SIG Entrepreneurship Paper Development Workshop – PDW is to facilitate a roundtable among young and experienced scholars in the field of entrepreneurship and support young scholars (Ph.D. students and/or early carrier scholars) to better address their contributions to the EURAM conference thanks to their papers' discussion with our community scholars.

The PDW wants to be a white laboratory, a friendly environment with a positive and fruitful exchange of ideas and food for thought.

### **Participants**

The 1st EURAM SIG Entrepreneurship PDW is aimed at young scholars interested in entrepreneurship. Young scholars will have the opportunity to present and discuss their works with a team of Volunteer Facilitators, including Experienced Referees and Discussants from the SIG Entrepreneurship community. Young scholars will have the opportunity to present their research projects (approximately 15 minutes).
